Commitment to the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers/ German Sports University Cologne (GSU)

We commit our involvement to the process of implementing a Human Resources Strategy for Researchers (HRS4R) in our institution.

The GSU is the country's only single-themed university in the domain of sport and exercise science. It therefore holds a special position amongst universities on a national and international level. Its research activities revolve around sport as a common and comprehensive reference point.
