

RE-ENDORSEMENT BY UNIVERSIDAD DE MURCIA TO THE PRINCIPLES OF "THE EUROPEAN CHARTER FOR RESEARCHERS" AND "THE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR RECRUITMENT OF RESEARCHERS"

The 5th July 2013, Universidad de Murcia undersigned the Commission Recommendation 2005/251/EC on the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers and expressed its full adhesion to this Recommendation.

Since then, Universidad de Murcia within its legal boundaries and in accordance with its internal policies, has been committed to applying the stated principles via its human resources policies for researchers and to promoting transparency, accessibility, equity and the pursuit of excellence in the recruitment of researchers.

Now, Universidad de Murcia goes one step forward. Having endorsed the 40 principles of Charter and Code, we notify the EC about our commitment to get involved into the process of implementing a Human Resources Strategy for Researchers (HRS4R) in our institution, in order to create and Open, Transparent and Merit-Based Recruitment process for researchers and to contribute to the development of their careers in the European Research Area.
