Declaration of Commitment to the Principles of the European Commission's Recommendation The European Charter for Researchers and The Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers

As an internationally competitive research university, the University of Turku hereby declares its commitment to the principles laid down in the Recommendation. With satisfaction we report that most of the issues included are already implemented in Finland and at the University of Turku. Further advancement of these principles is fully in line with the on-going development plans of the University.

The University of Turku's strategy for the period 2013 to 2016 includes six action plans. The focus of the action plan *Research University based on multidisciplinary strengths* lies in high-quality research as a basis for the University's operations.
