

## 4-year international pre-doctoral + PhD program Interdisciplinary research in biology Sorbonne University, Paris, France

Deadline March 16<sup>th</sup> 2023

The *Initiative for Interdisciplinary Research in Biology* (<u>*i-Bio*</u>) of the Sorbonne University Alliance in Paris is opening 4 positions for fully funded 4-year research programs. These will comprise one year of pre-doctoral rotation followed by a 3-year PhD contract to work at the interface between biology and other scientific disciplines.

- *Where:* At the <u>Paris-Seine Biology institute</u>, or the <u>Fer à Moulin institute</u> in Paris, affiliated with <u>Sorbonne University</u>.
- When: Starting October 15th 2023, for 4 years
- What: 1-year pre-doctoral experience with 3 successive rotational assignments of 3 months each, in 3 separate labs, starting October 15<sup>th</sup> 2023
  - $\bullet$  3-year PhD on one of the three projects, chosen at the end of the pre-doctoral year, starting October 1st 2024
  - List of pre-doctoral + PhD projects available <u>here</u>.
- *Who:* Students of any nationality holding a Master degree or equivalent
  - Individuals highly motivated to work at the interface between biology and other disciplines
  - Backgrounds in biology, chemistry, computational biology, engineering, mathematics or physics
- *How:* Deadline: candidates fill in the application form by March 16<sup>h</sup> 2023 at 4 pm.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> round selection: evaluation of applications by the *i-Bio* Executive Committee

• 2<sup>nd</sup> round selection: mid-May 2023, shortlisted candidates will be invited for a videointerview by a Selection Committee composed of scientific experts and representatives of the Doctoral Schools. Final results will be communicated by the end of May 2023.
