## **Declaration of commitment to the Recommendation of the European Commission on the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers**

The European Council of Doctoral Candidates and Junior Researchers (Eurodoc) has examined the Recommendation of the European Commission on the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers and fully endorses these principles.

As a representative of 34 national organisations, Eurodoc has long been active in promoting best practices in the research profession since 2002. By formally endorsing the Charter and the Code, Eurodoc wishes to confirm the importance of partnership in their effective implementation. We believe that researchers, employers and funders must work together to ensure that the Charter and the Code are fully and properly implemented and promoted.

To support this partnership principle, Eurodoc commits to continue with issuing policy recommendations on all aspects concerning the scientific community and engaging in dialogues with our partners in Europe and abroad. We call on our member organisations to assist in disseminating the Charter and the Code through their networks and formal endorsement.
