# What are the MSCA?



- Long-standing EU programme for researcher mobility, training and career development
- Bottom-up approach
- Open to all nationalities, career stages, and sectors
- Annual Calls



# What are the different possibilities?

### **Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions**



#### ITN

#### Innovative Training Networks

#### What does it offer?

High-quality research training delivered through international and interdisciplinary networks, industrial doctorates or joint doctorates

#### Who applies?

International networks of research organisations from the academic and nonacademic sectors

#### Who is funded?

Researchers at doctoral level (less than four years of full-time research experience and no doctoral degree)

Doctoral-level Multi-beneficiary



#### Individual Fellowships

#### What does it offer?

Opportunities to work on personal research projects by moving between countries and possibly sectors to acquire new skills

#### Who applies?

Individual researchers together with the host organisation

#### Who is funded?

Postdoctoral researchers

Post-Doctoral level Mono-beneficiary

### Research and Innovation Staff Exchange

#### What does it offer?

The exchange of staff members involved in research and innovation to develop sustainable collaborative projects and the transfer of knowledge

#### Who applies?

International networks of research organisations from the academic and non-academic sectors

#### Who is funded?

Researchers, technical, administrative and managerial staff of any nationality and at all career levels

### Co-Funding of Regional, National and International Programmes

#### What does it offer?

Regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in researchers' training, mobility and career development

#### Who applies?

Organisations funding or managing doctoral programmes or fellowship programmes

#### Who is funded?

Researchers at doctoral and postdoctoral level

Doctoral and Post-Doctoral Mono-beneficiary

# Which organisations?



#### **Academic sector**

- Higher education establishments (awarding academic degrees)
- Non-profit research organisations (primary mission research)
- International European interest organisations (e.g. CERN, EMBL)



#### Non-academic sector

- Any entity not included in the academic sector:
- e.g. large companies, SMEs, NGOs, museums, hospitals, international organisations (e.g. UN, WHO)

# An MSCA-IF PROJECT I

Open to all fields: CHE, SOC, ECO, ENG, ENV, LIF, MAT, PHY

#### **Actors:**

- 1 Experienced Researcher (PhD holder or minimum 4years experience in Research) Any nationality\*
- 1 Host institution (beneficiary from MS or AC) (for Global fellowships + 1 partner institution from third country)
- 1 Supervisor

\*(residency condition for nationals of non-Member States/Associated countries for Re-integration panel/Global fellowships)



# An MSCA-IF PROJECT II

#### **Activities:**

- Training-through-research: individual personalised action
- Hands-on training activities for developing **scientific** (new techniques, instruments) and **transferable skills** (proposal preparation, IPR management, task coordination, supervising & monitoring, exploitation of research results)
- Inter-sectoral or interdisciplinary **transfer of knowledge** (secondments)
- Organisation of scientific/training/dissemination events
- Communication, outreach activities
- **Training** dedicated to gender issues







# Global Fellowships (GF)

### 1. RESEARCHER RULE

En 200

If not European, the researcher must have resided at least 5 consecutive years in Europe before leaving (long term residency)



#### 2. MOBILITY RULE

Not resided, worked, studied > 12 months in the 3 years in the country of the **Third Country partner** organisation (outgoing = phase 1)

Evaluation of proposals: October - December 2020


Launch Grant preparation: Early February 2021

# The Evaluation


- Ca. **10,000 proposals** received per year (funding for ca. 1,500)
- 4,500 experts from around the world, working remotely
- 8 Scientific Panels (LIF, PHY, MAT, ENG, CHE, ENV, SOC, ECO)



Short proposals (ca. 10 pages)



# Good to Know...

- Time-to-Grant: 5m + 3m (counted from Call closure date)
- Flexible project start dates: up to 24m after Call closure
- Part-time work is possible (subject to approval)
- Secondments are encouraged (especially inter-sectoral), but must be within EU/AC
- Funding and Tenders Portal: reference point for proposal submission,
   Call documentation
- Next Call Deadline: 9 September 2020
