





Europe open to the U.S.

- Research cooperation for U.S.-based researchers in the form of European Research Council (ERC) grants and Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) fellowships.
 - Bottom-up projects
 - ERC's sole evaluation criterion is excellence
 - MSCA's criteria are excellence, impact, and quality and efficiency of the implementation



European Research Council (ERC) grants

- ERC Synergy Grants (ERC SyG)
 - Enabling 2-4 Principal Investigators and their teams to bring together complementary skills, knowledge, and resources in new ways, in order to address ambitious research problems.
- ERC Starting Grants (ERC StG)
 - Supporting excellent Principal Investigators starting their own independent research team or program
- ERC Consolidator Grants (ERC CoG)
 - Supporting excellent Principal Investigators consolidating their own independent research team or program
- ERC Advanced Grants (ERC AdG)
 - Supporting excellent Principal Investigators at the career stage at which they are already established research leaders with a recognized track record of research
- ERC Proof of Concept Grants (ERC PoC)
 - Supporting holders of an ERC frontier research grant to verify the innovation potential of ideas arising from their ERC-funded project

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) fellowships

- Doctoral Networks (DN): Research training of doctoral candidates
- Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Career development of Postdocs
- Staff Exchanges (SE): Cooperation by means of staff exchange
- Co-funding of regional, national, and international programs (COFUND): Co-Funding of Doctoral or Fellowship Programs
- MSCA and Citizens: Pan-European Researchers' Night to promote research careers



Bilateral cooperation

- For collaborative research projects, U.S. researchers **bring their own funding to the project**. In exceptional cases, U.S. entities may be entitled to funding **when this possibility is mentioned in the relevant calls for proposals** or in cases where the U.S. partner is essential to the project. This is typically the case in calls related to health research.
 - This is due to the U.S.'s status as a Third Country
 - Low- and middle-income countries are automatically eligible for funding
- Third Country entities can join European partners
