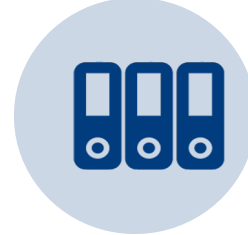

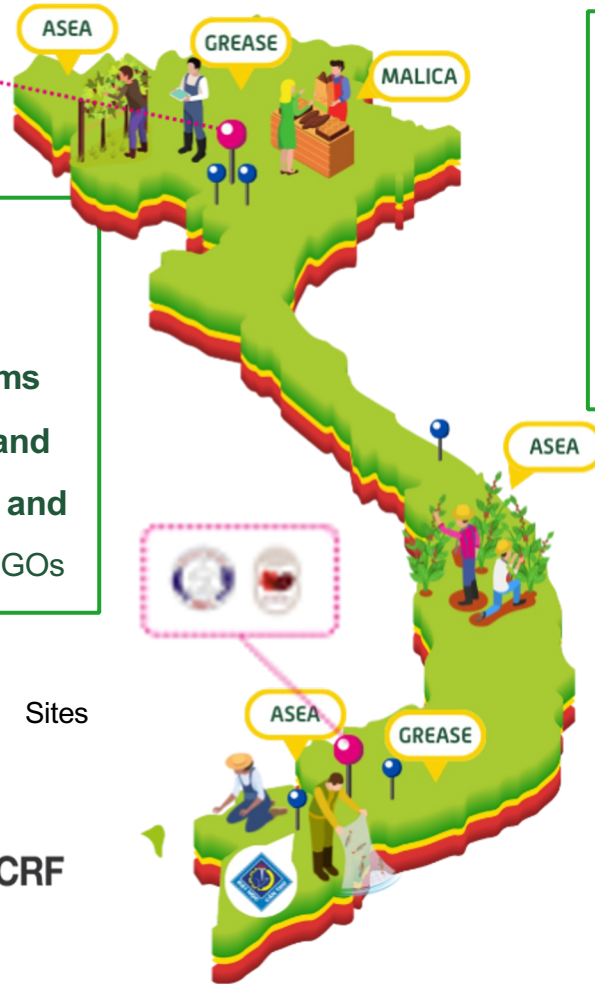

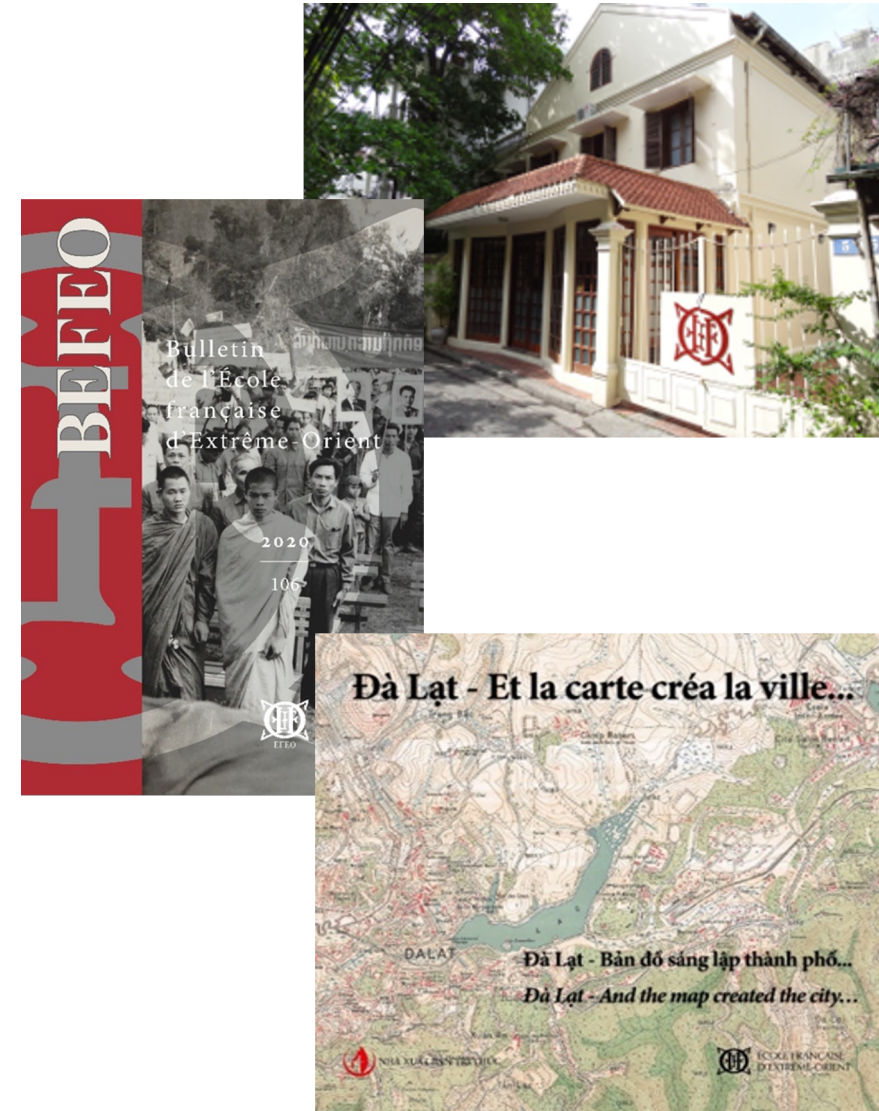
Fieldwork in Asia

The École française d'Extrême-Orient (EFEO), or French School of Asian Studies, was founded in 1898 in Saigon. The mission of the EFEO, a public institution under the aegis of the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research, is to study the classical civilizations of Asia through the humanities and social sciences. Leading scholars are working at the EFEO's 18 centres and branch offices in Asia.

In 1993, a Centre was opened in Hanoi, under the purview of the Vietnamese Academy of Social Sciences, which enabled the EFEO to revive its Vietnamese studies programs. The Hanoi Centre, which is equipped with a library, acts as a publisher (epigraphic corpora), and conducts research in ancient and contemporary history, anthropology, epigraphy, anthropology, and archaeology. Another branch of the EFEO is active in Hồ Chí Minh City,

The centres' programs, which are carried out in collaboration with Vietnamese colleagues (Vietnam National Archives, Museums, Universities, Institutes...) include training in methodology and field research for young researchers from the Vietnamese Academy of Social Sciences as well as students from other partner universities.

Since the vast majority of EFEO members carry out field studies in Asia, the emergence of contemporary issues is obviously of relevance for the School.

***Vietnamica* – History, Epigraphy and Digital Humanities : Research on Stelae Inscriptions and Documentary Sources of Classical Vietnamese History**

Funded by the European Research Council (ERC), the Vietnamica programme is under the direction of Philippe Papin. It brings together several researchers and students from the École Pratique des Hautes Études, the Institute of Hán-Nôm Studies in Hanoi (Vietnamese Academy of Social Sciences) and the University of Social Sciences and Humanities (Vietnam National University). It is conducted by the École Pratique des Hautes Études. Its operator in Vietnam is the Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie.

It aims to analyse and process the rubbings that reproduce the inscriptions engraved on the thousands of donation stelae erected in Vietnamese villages from the 16th to the 20th century. These inscriptions, written in Chinese and vernacular scripts, open up new perspectives for writing a history of religious beliefs, economy and social structures of the rural world.

In addition to specialised historical studies, including monographs on pious donations to village shrines, the Vietnamica programme is dedicated to the comprehensive treatment of the inscriptions using digital humanities techniques.
