# CDTI – The Spanish Innovation Agency






- Public Entity Ministry of Science, Innovation and Universities





# International R&D Cooperation with Vietnam

### **Projects**

Partners: (1+1) at least 1 partner from Vietnam and 1 partner from Spain

- ✓ Spanish side must be led by a **company** => Collaboration with other Spanish R&D entities is permitted and it can be funded
- ✓ Vietnamese side could be led by any **R&D entity** headquartered in Vietnam => company, research institute, university, technological centre, hospital, etc.
- ✓ The Vietnamese partner and the Spanish partner must be independent.
- ✓ Balanced proposals (máx budget 70% Spanish side)



Programs

Bilateral: Spain + Vietnam

Multilateral: Spain + Vietnam + other countries

# International R&D Cooperation with

**Vietnam** 

Bilateral

- The participants from both countries receive funding from their governments
- Principle "No money crossing-borders": Each country funds its own participants
- Possible if CDTI has a bilateral agreement with the Government of the other country

Vietnam – State Agency for Technological Development (SATI) under MOST: NEW Framework of collaboration

Global Innovation Index 2023 - Spain stands in the 29<sup>th</sup> position in the world Source: WIPO, World Intellectual Property Organization








