# **Participation & Eligibility - Brazil**

Participants from Brazil are **not automatically eligible for funding** and usually have to participate at their own cost.

#### They can receive exceptional funding, if:

- a) Brazil is explicitly identified in the work programme and call for proposals as being eligible for funding
- b) the granting authority considers that their participation as a beneficiary is essential for implementing the project, for example in view of their:
  - ✓ outstanding competence/expertise
  - ✓ access to particular research infrastructures
  - ✓ access to particular geographical environments
  - ✓ access to particular data













# **Eligibility – Type of Participants**



#### **Individual researchers**

Are automatically eligible for funding



- MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships
- ERC Grants



#### Institutions taking part in consortia

Are not automatically eligible for funding

#### **Examples:**

 In collaborative projects: Research and Innovation Actions (RIA), Innovation Actions (IA), Coordination and Support Actions (CSA)











# **Support from Brazilian Funding Agencies**

# Administrative Arrangement (AA) on mechanisms to support EU-Brazil cooperation in research and innovation activities



- ✓ Previously implemented in the context of Horizon 2020
- ✓ In the context of Horizon Europe: finalizing signature procedures for the new AA
- ✓ Objective: to promote stronger EU-Brazil cooperation in R&I based on mutual benefit

# **AA: Mechanisms for Cooperation**

The AA allows the Sides to implement mechanisms to support / facilitate collaborative activities and enhance mutual knowledge and awareness within their respective frameworks, laws and funding programmes

#### How?

#### 1. Support to collaborative activities

- a. Co-financing from Brazilian agencies for Brazilian entities taking part in Horizon Europe collaborative actions, including those under Horizon
  - **Europe Partnerships and Missions**
- b. Twinning of parallel collaborative activities
- c. Coordinated calls for proposals
- 2. Enhancement of mutual knowledge and awareness











# How does it work in practice?

As under Horizon 2020, same logic is maintained

The involved Funding Agencies at Federal or State level can:



- Publish Guidelines for orienting participation in Horizon Europe Calls
- Provide support though targeted calls, matching Horizon Europe Calls
- Make available existing funding programs at national level, to cover Brazilian participation
- Promote Twinning activities among respectively funded projects
- In all cases: need to consult the respective Funding Agency involved in order to verify the specific rules and modalities of the funding provided
