The position is open to persons who meet the conditions set out in the Act on Higher and Science of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574, as amended) and the statute of the University of Warsaw.

The candidate is expected to:

- hold a LL.D degree with distinction in European law;
- demonstrate a proven academic output in the scope of European Union law, with particular consideration of EU antidiscrimination law;
- have excellent command of Polish and command of at least two foreign languages confirmed by certificates;
- have at least one year of experience in regular self-standing teaching of EU law at academic level;
- adhere to the principles of scientific ethics.

Basic duties:

- carrying out research in the field of European Union law, with particular emphasis on the EU antidiscrimination law
- carrying out research regarding Polish law in the context of regulations of European Union law,
- carrying out research on foreign law in the scope necessary to carry out research concerning European Union law,
- teaching activity in the field of European Union law – institutional and substantive law of the EU

Candidates should submit the following documents:
