The Director of Mossakowski Medical Research Institute, Polish Academy of Sciences announces the competition for the position of the assistant professor or professor of the institute or professor\* and Head of the Laboratory of Protein Engineering to operationalize statutory tasks, conduct research projects and implement one's vision of scientific development of the Laboratory.

**Required documents:**

- application to the Director to be entrusted with the function under the competition,
- documents to prove professional qualifications required for the position in question, including document confirming being a scientific degree or title holder,
- a cover letter containing information concerning scientific interest, scientific independence including participation in publications and grants, team management and development program, description of the planned staff management strategy as well as financing operations, functioning and development of the unit the applicant is applying for,
- the applicant's CV including information about education, an occupational and scientific career as well as research, teaching, and organizational achievements,
- list of publications: publications before the doctorate, publications including doctorate's results, publications after doctorate and after habilitation, and the bibliometric analysis; other documents to prove the applicant's scientific achievements required in "Regulations of the employment for the scientific positions in MMRI PAS", appropriate for the position to which the competition relates,
- a statement that Mossakowski Medical Research Institute, Polish Academy of Sciences shall be the applicant's primary place of employment and the managerial function shall be performed full-time,
- documents confirming the fulfillment of other requirements specified in the announcement of the competition for the position in this competition announcement.

#### **INFORMATION CLAUSE ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING**

3. Your data will be processed to carry out a recruitment process and select an employee and conclude a contract for employment at the MMRI PAS.

MMRI PAS processes Your data concerning a legal obligation (Article 6.1.c of the GDPR) according to Article 22<sup>1</sup> § 1 of the Act of 26 June 1974 Labour Code or Your consent understood by sending them to MMRI PAS (Article 6.1.a of the GDPR) for data not listed on Labour Code, and their application does not affect the possibility of participating in the recruitment/competition.
