

[LIVESTREAMs] Jon Jones vs Stipe Miocic Live Free UFC 309 Heavyweight Fight On November 17, 2024

Ultimate Fighting Championship (UFC) is just one day away from the upcoming UFC 309 pay-per-view (PPV) event on ESPN+, scheduled for this Sat. night (Nov. 16, 2024) at Madison Square Garden in New York City.

UFC 309 live stream: how to watch Jones vs Miocic start time, odds



Former champion Stipe Miocic looks to teach Jon Jones a thing or two when he challenges Jon Jones at UFC 309 for the UFC heavyweight title. The event takes place at Madison Square Garden and will air on ESPN+ PPV in the U.S.

Jones dominated the light heavyweight division for years as its champion, beating a who's who of killers. The only dent on his resume is outside the octagon, where he has been involved in numerous controversies. "Bones" beat Cyril Gane to win the UFC heavyweight title in 2023, which was the last time he competed.

Miocic fights for the first time since 2021 when lineal heavyweight champion Francis Ngannou knocked him out. The 42-year-old had bided his time waiting to compete for gold again and plans to show the world that age is only a number.

Jones is new to the division, while Miocic helped guide it to prosperity. He believes his experience will trump Jones' inexperience within the division.

“Definitely a different ballgame when it comes to heavyweight,” said Miocic via The New York Post. “We’ve got bigger guys who hit harder... a lot of things that are different. We’ll see. I have some things up my sleeve, just like he does.”

UFC 309 will be at Madison Square Garden on November 16. The early prelims start at 6 p.m. ET, while the prelims are at 8 p.m. ET. The main card starts at 10 p.m. ET, and Jon Jones and Stipe Miocic should make their way to the octagon around 12:30 a.m. ET, depending on how long the undercard fights last.

There are multiple ways to watch the UFC 309 prelims on Saturday.

The prelims, starting at 8 p.m. ET will air on ESPN+. You can subscribe to ESPN+ for \$11.99 on a monthly subscription and \$119.99 on an annual subscription. For a limited time, get 12 months of ESPN+ for the price of 9 with the purchase of an annual plan.

It will also be streamed on Fubo which carries ESPN News and offers a free trial. It is also available on Hulu which offers FX via the Disney bundle.

The UFC 308 main card is available via pay-per-view on ESPN+. The PPV price for UFC 309 is \$79.99 for current subscribers. For a limited time, get 12 months of ESPN+ for the price of 9 with the purchase of an annual plan.

The UFC 309 main card is available via pay-per-view on Foxtel's Main Event, which also requires a subscription. Alternatively, the event can be purchased through the streaming platform Kayo, with no subscription needed. The PPV price for UFC 309 is \$59.95.

UFC 309 will also be available on TNT Sports (£3.99/month or £39.99/year via Discovery+).

Jon Jones makes his long-awaited return from injury to defend his UFC heavyweight title against Stipe Miocic tonight at Madison Square Garden in New York City.

Jones, 37, is the current heavyweight champion and a two-time former light heavyweight champion, while Miocic, 42, is a two-time former champion at this weight.

The title fight is supported by a strong undercard, which includes the lightweight rematch between Charles Oliveira and Michael Chandler. Follow live updates below.

The Ultimate Fighting Championship, or UFC 309 Fight Night, will feature the lightweight co-main event between Charles Oliveira (Brazil) and Michael Chandler (United States) on Sunday, Nov. 17, 2024. Oliveira is 34-10-0, 1NC, and Chandler is 23-8-0. Let us see some statistics comparing the fighters:

The co-main event fight, UFC 309, will be between Oliveira and Chandler, so remember to watch it on Sunday at 8:30 AM (IST).

Current heavyweight champion Jon Jones will make the first defence of his undisputed title against Stipe Miocic (facing page, below) at UFC 309 in New York on November 17.

The long-awaited fight was first scheduled to headline UFC 295 almost a year ago, but Jones suffered an injury that kept him out of action for the rest of 2023.

Jones made his switch from light heavyweight to heavyweight at UFC 285 against Cyril Gane. He put on an impressive show and earned a first-round win to become one of the few fighters to hold titles in multiple divisions.

“I was preparing for Stipe (Miocic) no differently than any other athlete I prepared for. At this point in my career, I’ve fought so many different styles: left-handed fighters, right-handed fighters, strikers, wrestlers. I will say it’s there’s nothing too different about training for Stipe,” said Jones in the pre-fight press conference.

On the other hand, the bout is Miocic’s first since he lost the title in March 2021. The Ohio native holds the UFC record for most consecutive heavyweight title defences (three) and most finishes in UFC heavyweight title fights (four).

The 42-year-old will hope to become a three-time heavyweight champion when he enters the octagon later this month.

Meanwhile, the co-main event is set to be a five-round rematch between former lightweight champion Charles Oliveira and Michael Chandler.

The bout comes three-and-a-half years after their championship fight in Houston at UFC 262 when Oliveira knocked out Chandler in a come-from-behind effort.

Oliveira went on to defend his belt once but is coming off two losses in his last three fights to reigning lightweight champion Islam Makhachev and Arman Tsarukyan.
