UFC 309, headlined by Jon Jones vs. Stipe Miocic, airs live on Saturday, Nov. 16, 2024 (11/16/24) from Madison Square Garden in New York City.

In the main event, UFC heavyweight champion Jon Jones puts his belt on the line against two-time champion Stipe Miocic in the main event.

Jones is 18-0 with one no-contest since his only loss, while Miocic has won three of his past five fights. This is Jones' first fight since he won the UFC heavyweight title at UFC 285, while Miocic last competed in a knockout loss at UFC 260 on March 27, 2021.

Former UFC champion Charles Oliveira squares off against Michael Chandler in a five-round lightweight rematch in the co-main event.

Madison Square Garden will be the place to be when Jon Jones defends the UFC heavyweight title against Stipe Miocic at UFC 309.

UFC 309 is available in the U.K. via TNT Sports. The prelims, starting at 1 a.m. GMT, will air on UFC Fight Pass.

UFC 309 preview

Jones held the UFC light heavyweight title at various points for about ten years. Considered a pound-for-pound great, "Bones" vacated the belt in 2020 and didn't compete for three years, returning in 2023 after Francis Ngannou left the organization.

In March 2022, he faced Ciryl Gane for the UFC heavyweight title, stopping him in the opening round to become a two-division champion. He was supposed to fight Miocic last November before an injury forced the fight to get nixed.

Miocic won the UFC heavyweight title in 2016 and defended it four times. The 42-year-old traded wins and losses with Daniel Cormier for the belt from 2018 to 2020. Miocic last fought in March 2021, losing the belt against Ngannou.

The fireman returns to the octagon looking to hold gold again, though it is unknown if it is his last fight, win or lose.

The co-main event is a rematch between Michael Chandler and Charles Oliveira. The two fought at UFC 262 in 2021 for the UFC lightweight title. Chandler almost finished Oliveira early, but the latter stormed back and took Chandler out in round two.

Oliveira has since lost the belt and looks to return to title contention, while Chandler, who has waited to fight Conor McGregor for two years, moves on.

Uncrowned has UFC 309 results, live round-by-round updates, start time, and highlights for the Jon Jones vs. Stipe Miocic fight card on Saturday at Madison Square Garden in New York. Following a near two-year layoff, UFC champion Jones make his first defense of the heavyweight title against former two-time beltholder Stipe Miocic in the night's main event.

Jones (27-1, 1 NC) and Miocic (20-4) were supposed to fight at Madison Square Garden in November 2023, however the bout fell apart due to a Jones injury shoulder.

Jones, 37, submitted Ciryl Gane in the first round of his most recent UFC appearance in March 2023 to capture the vacant UFC heavyweight title in his divisional debut. Prior to that, Jones was a longtime UFC light heavyweight champion who held the belt under multiple reigns.

Miocic, 42, likewise is a record-setting former UFC titleholder who steps in off a long layoff and holds the UFC benchmarks for most consecutive (3) and combined (4) heavyweight title defenses. Miocic's most recent Octagon appearance came in a March 2021 knockout loss to Francis Ngannou, while his most recent win came in an August 2020 title defense to complete his trilogy with Daniel Cormier.

UFC 309: JONES vs MIOCIC Updates: Due to medical issues, Lucas Almeida has been removed from his featherweight bout with David Onama. Replacing Almeida will be UFC newcomer Roberto Romero, who makes his debut with five of his eight wins coming via first-round finish. This bout will now take place at lightweight.

Additionally, the lightweight bout between Mauricio Ruffy and James Llontop will now take place at a catchweight of 165 lbs.

MMA Fighting has a live stream watch party for Saturday's UFC 309 event, which takes place at Madison Square Garden in New York City. In the main event, UFC heavyweight champion Jon Jones defends his title for the first time against two-time champ Stipe Miocic.

Join MMA Fighting's Mike Heck, Jed Meshew, and other special guests to watch along with UFC 309 as the main card happens.

In the co-main event, former lightweight champion Charles Oliveira looks to make it 2-0 against Michael Chandler in a highly anticipated five-round co-main event rematch.

UFC 309 also includes a middleweight battle between blue-chipper Bo Nickal and longtime promotional veteran Paul Craig, while ranked flyweights Karine Silva and Viviane Araujo compete in a pivotal divisional matchup.

The main card opens with fan-friendly catchweight bout as punisher Mauricio Ruffy faces James Llontop in a bout that likely won't see the judges' scorecards.

UFC 309 takes place Saturday, and you can join us for live round-by-round coverage and official results beginning at 6 p.m. ET (3 p.m. PT). UFC 309 (pay-per-view, ESPNews/Hulu/FX, ESPN+) takes place at Madison Square Garden in New York.

In the headliner, heavyweight champion Jon Jones (27-1 MMA, 21-1 UFC) puts his title on the line for the first time when he takes on former champ Stipe Miocic (20-4 MMA, 14-4 UFC) in a fight delayed by a year. In the co-feature, former lightweight champ Charles Oliveira (34-10 MMA, 22-10 UFC) takes on Michael Chandler (23-8 MMA, 2-3 UFC) after he was left at the alter by Conor McGregor.

Follow along with our round-by-round updates and official results beginning at approximately 6 p.m. ET for the early prelims on Hulu and ESPN+, 8 p.m. ET for the prelims on ESPNews, FX, Hulu and ESPN+, and 10 p.m. ET for the main card on pay-per-view (via ESPN+).

Ultimate Fighting Championship (UFC) heads to "The Big Apple" TONIGHT (Sat., Nov. 16, 2024) with UFC 309, taking place inside Madison Square Garden, streaming LIVE on ESPN+ PPV. UFC 309's pay-per-view (PPV) main event sees mercurial Heavyweight champion, Jon Jones, meeting former division champion, Stipe Miocic, in a legacy-defining showdown for the ages. The co-feature, meanwhile, is an all-violence match-up with Charles Oliveira vs. Michael Chandler 2.

UFC 309's late "Prelims" are headlined by Jonathan Martinez vs. Marcus McGhee. This four-fight portion of the card is also expected to include Chris Weidman vs. Eryk Anders and Jim Miller vs. Damon Jackson, among other bouts (full fight card here).

The early "Prelims" (start time 6 p.m. ET) will headlined by Marcin Tybura vs. Jhonata Diniz (who lost his date with Derrick Lewis last week). UFC 309's early "Prelims" also host Mickey Gall vs. Ramiz Brahimaj, Bassil Hafez vs. Oban Elliott and Veronica Hardy vs. Eduarda Moura.
