- Promote attractive working and employment conditions

MSCA and COVID-19

- Confinement measures with harsh impact
 - > on R&I activities
 - > on MSCA fellows' mobility
- Issue raised by
 - > MSCA fellows
 - Stakeholder organisations
 - > MEPs
 - through
 - > Social media
 - Newspaper articles
 - Letters to and meetings with the Commissioner and President

Guidance for project coordinators and fellows

- Requests for paid extensions of MSCA projects
- Information note for MSCA IF projects April 2020
- Individualised guidance by REA project officers
- Maximum flexibility measures taken by EC and REA
 - ✓ Paid remote work and telework
 - ✓ Postponement and reorganisation of tasks
 - ✓ Part-time arrangements and extension of contracts
 - ✓ Delayed start dates
 - ✓ Paid during absences of up to 30 days
 - ✓ Use of unspent institutional unit costs to cover salaries if agreed suspension
 - ✓ Project continuation even if laboratories are closed
- Additional resources and measures by MS and host institutions ("duty to care")
- MSCA-specific FAQs published on the Funding and Tenders Portal more coming soon

Consultation with stakeholders

- MCAA Survey close follow-up of individual cases
- Meeting with 9 organisations on COVID-19's impact on doctoral studies, research, training and mobility
 - Impact on MSCA projects and flexibility measures by institutions
 - Impact on women, young and mobile researchers
 - Issues with secondments (ITN and IF notably)
 - Impact and delays on research activities, field work, networking, motivation, increased pressure
 - Impact on research group leaders snowball effect on PhDs and postdocs
 - ✓ Virtual and blended mobility (e.g. rules on thesis defence)
 - ✓ Increased interest in outreach, dissemination and open science

Consultation with stakeholders

- Current areas impacted by COVID-19, possible solutions and coordinated steps
 - Less interest for staff mobility, possible boost of other mobility after COVID-19
 - Persisting travel and visa restrictions
 - Quality of online activities, need for proper infrastructure
 - Need to reinforce communication on force majeure cases
 - ✓ Increase links and communication between fellows, MSCA projects, institutions, REA and Commission for a better guidance to projects and fellows
 - ✓ Guidelines for supervisors and career development
 - ✓ Emergency fund
 - ✓ Identification of legal barriers at national level for realisation of the ERA (mobility, labour law, etc.) > Study by DG RTD
 - ✓ Improve info on visa regulations


- MSCA COVID-19 page launched in March 2020

MSCA COVID-19 Portfolio

- Offer possible reorientation of work plans
- Redirect to relevant funding sources and COVID-19 funding
- Identification of COVID-19 results
- Indentification of EU-funded projects contributing to:
 - Health Emergency Fighting
 - Resilience and preparedness
 - > Long term actions
- 655 projects identified for all EU R&I programmes
 - > 81 MSCA with a direct link to COVID-19
 - > of which 40 with COVID-19 results

Horizon Results Platform – COVID-19

- New platform for EU-funded projects to promote their results
 - Support policy decisions
 - > Find partners and collaboration
 - > Find funding, loans or investment
 - > Find support to bring results to market

- Dedicated section to COVID-19 results
- 13 COVID-19 results published by MSCA projects
