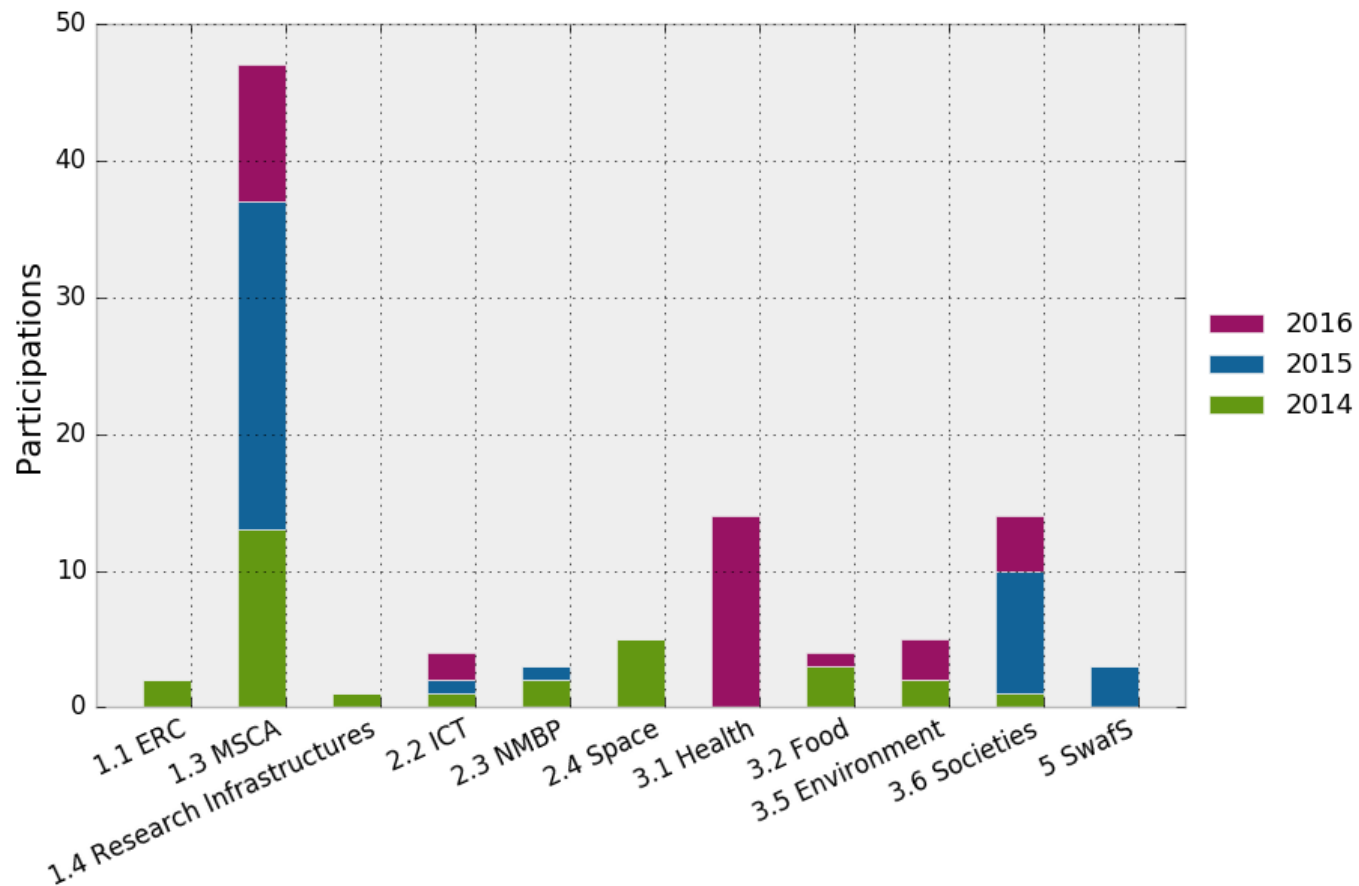

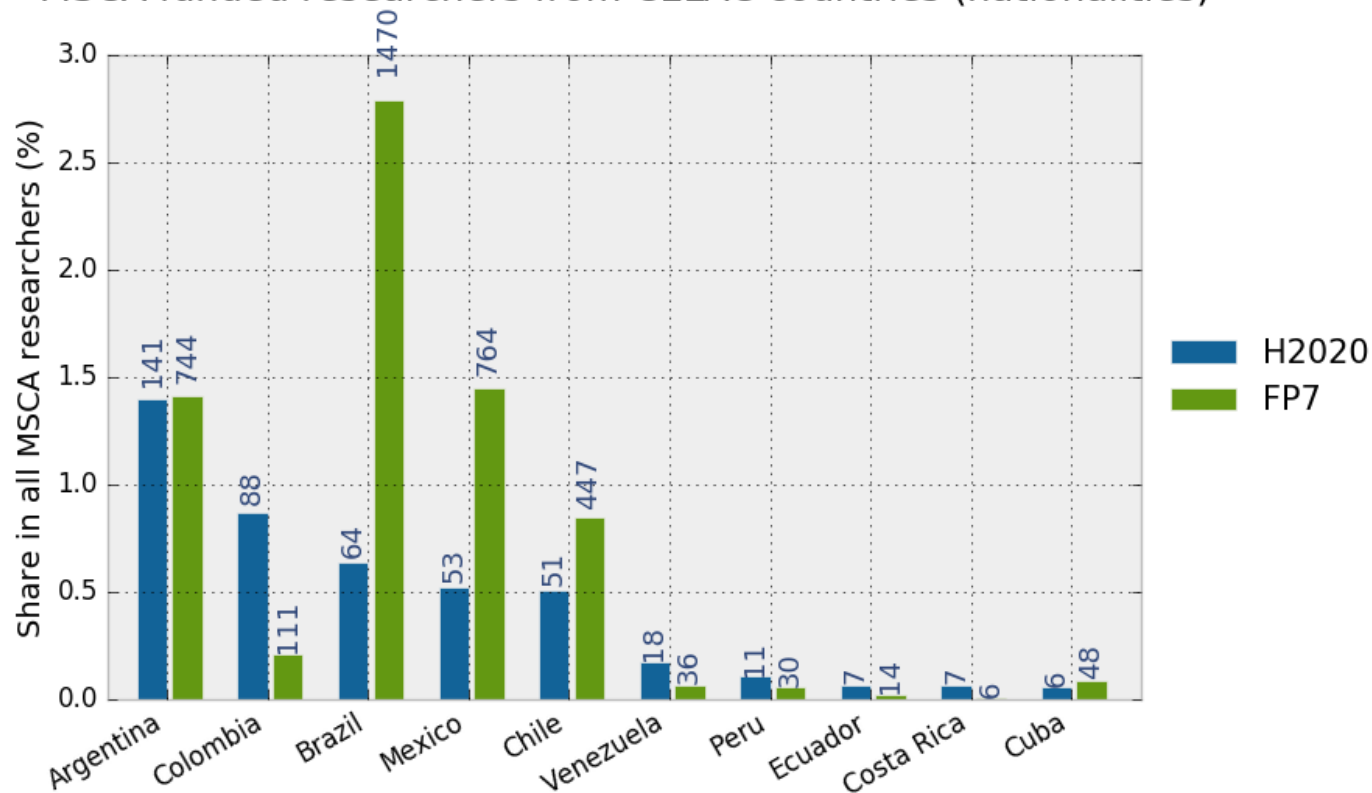

## MSCA funded researchers from CELAC countries (nationalities)

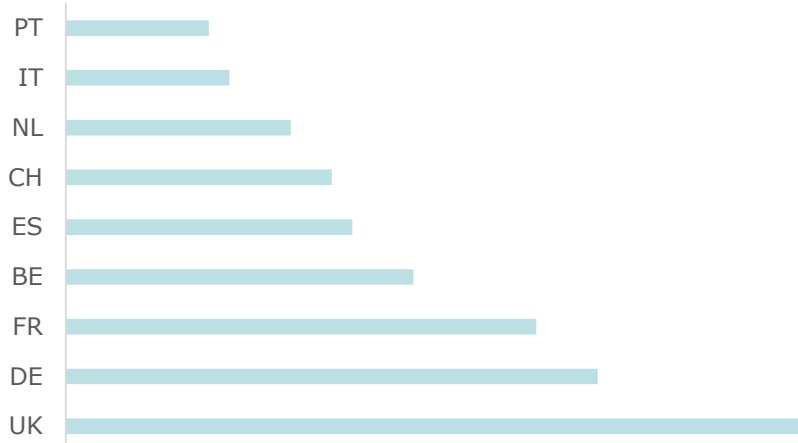

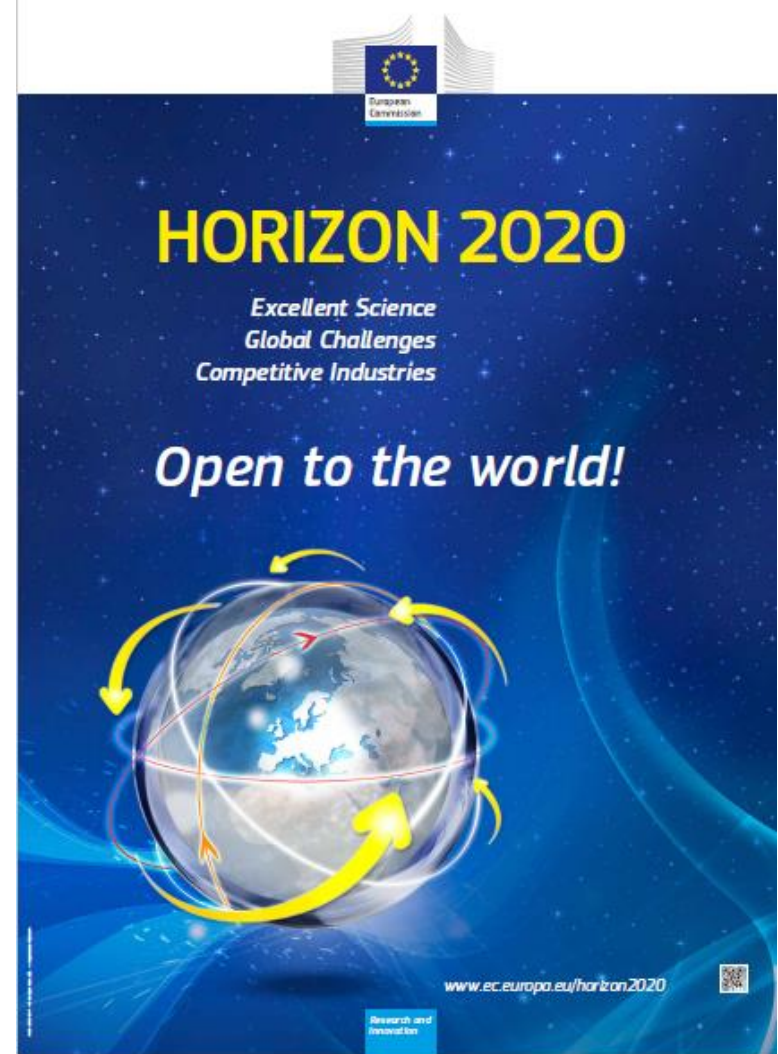
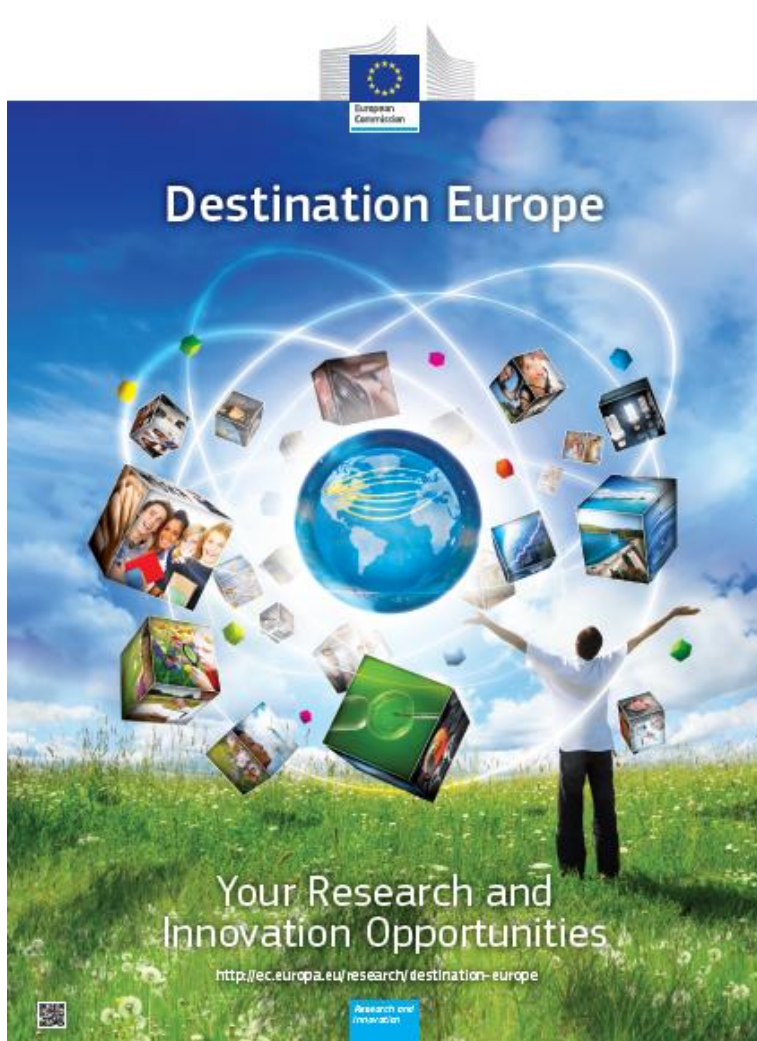

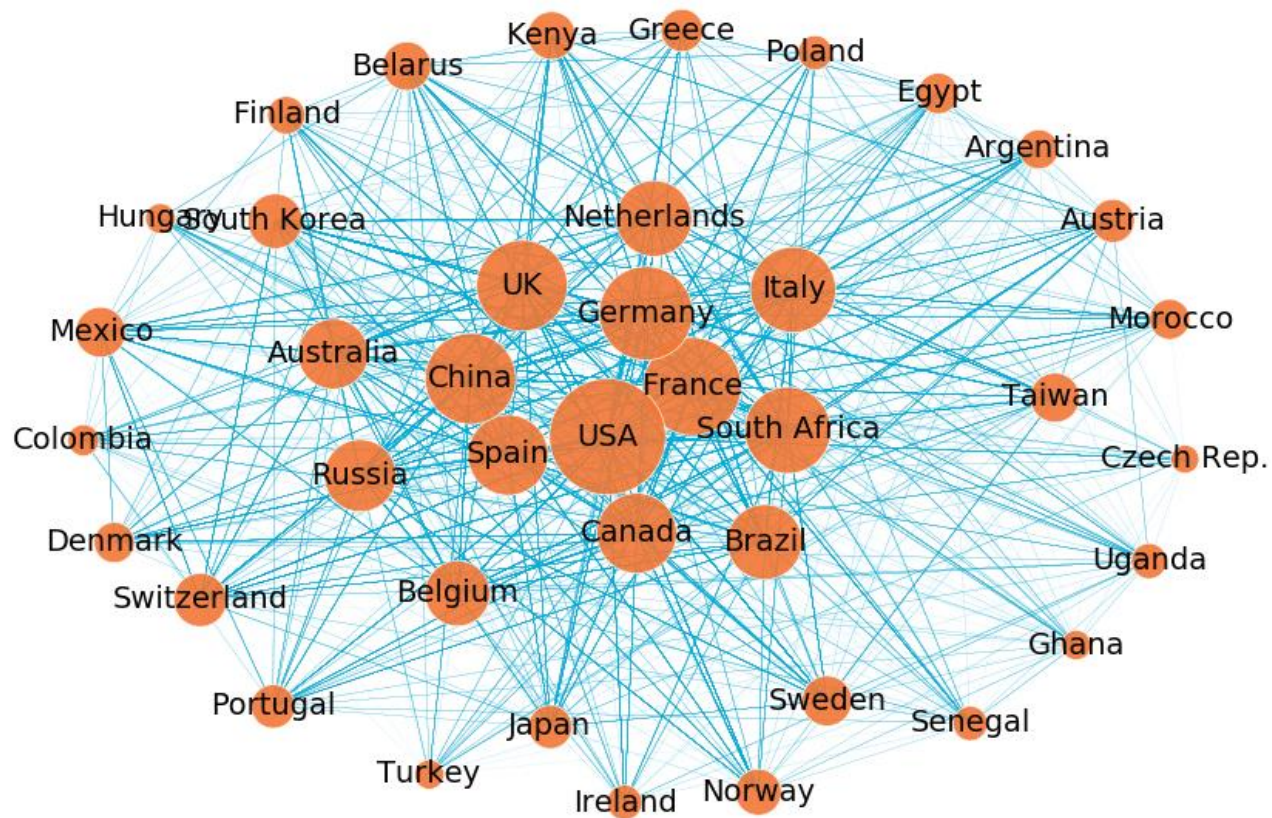

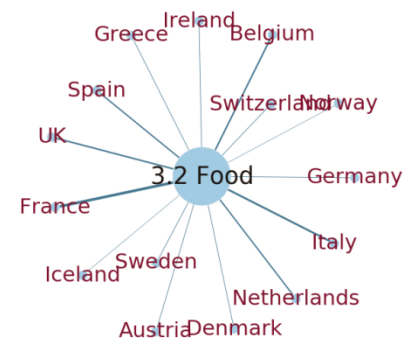
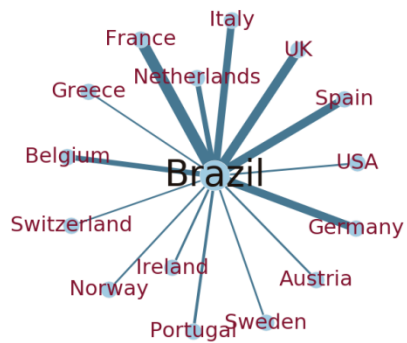
## Collaborative links of non associated countries



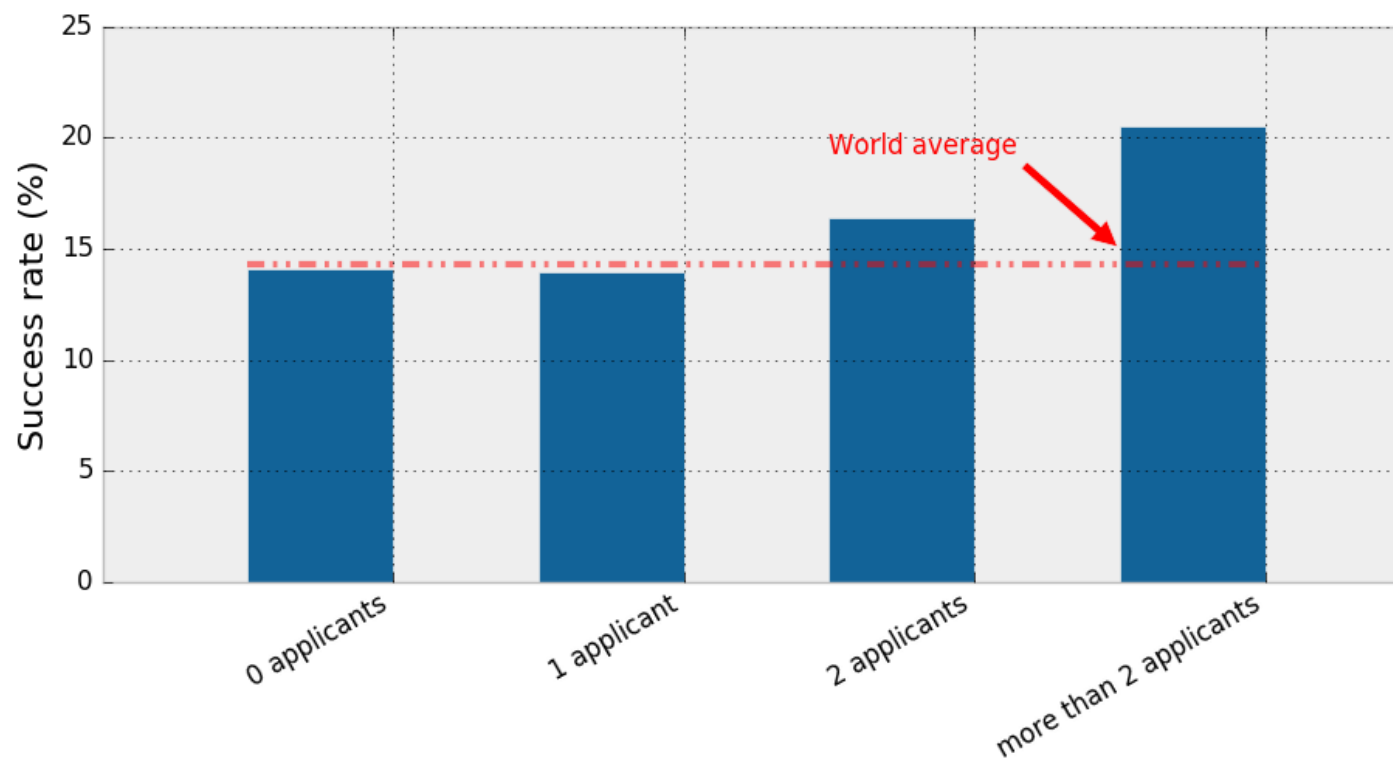
